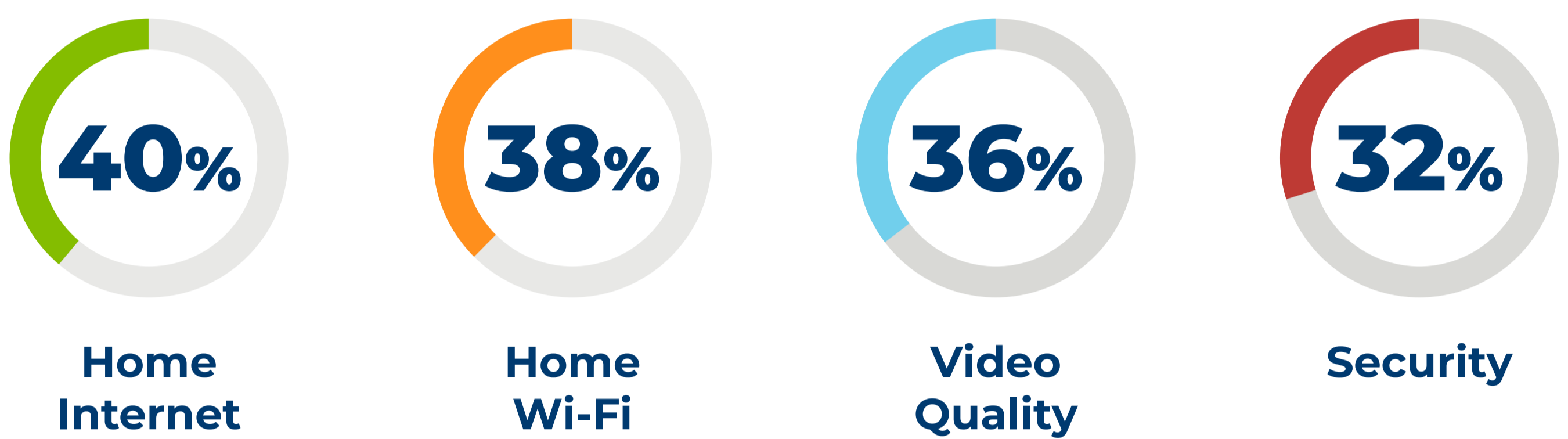


5 reasons to consider SASE for remote work

 SASE offers the ability to connect and protect remote workers and branch locations with the ease of one service
- 2 Security**
 SASE can be integrated with overall security architectures and expanded with cloud and endpoint security
- 3 Performance**
 SASE solutions can be bundled with unified communications, ensuring video conferencing and collaboration performance
- 4 Productivity**
 Managed services reduce IT administrative burdens, providing SD-WAN management and security threat detection and response
- 5 Automation & Analytics**
 Some solutions offer AI or AIOps to help automate performance optimization with a virtual network analyst

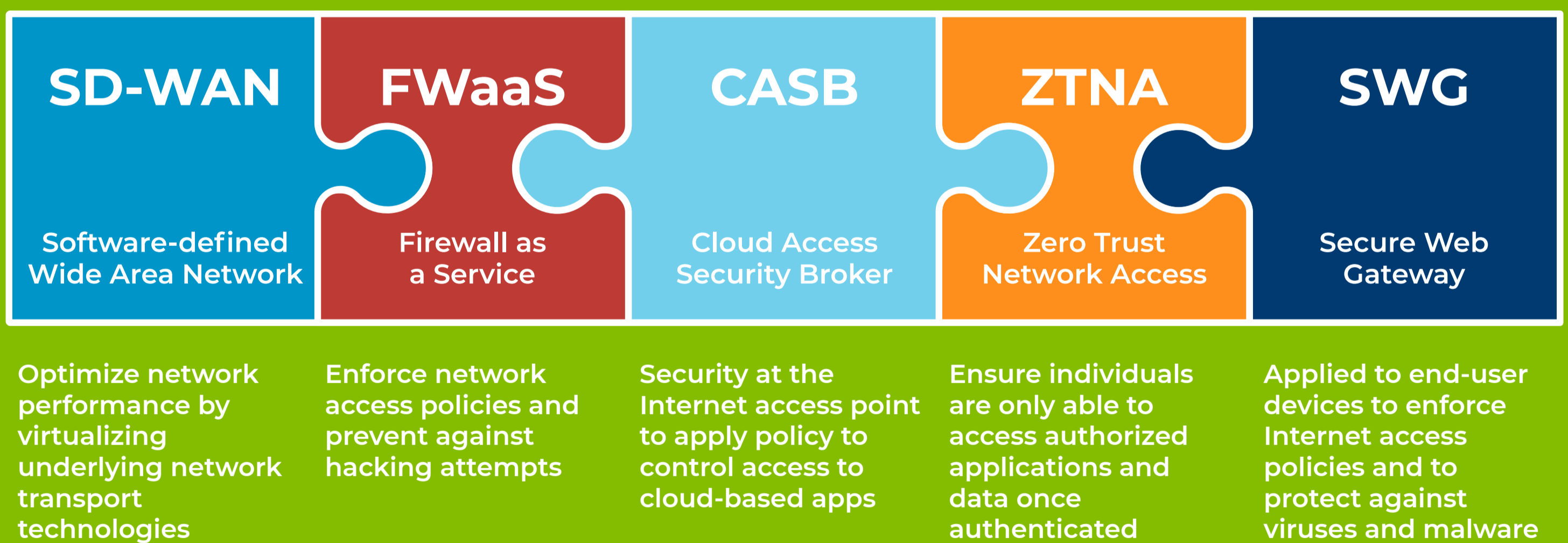


SASE to the rescue

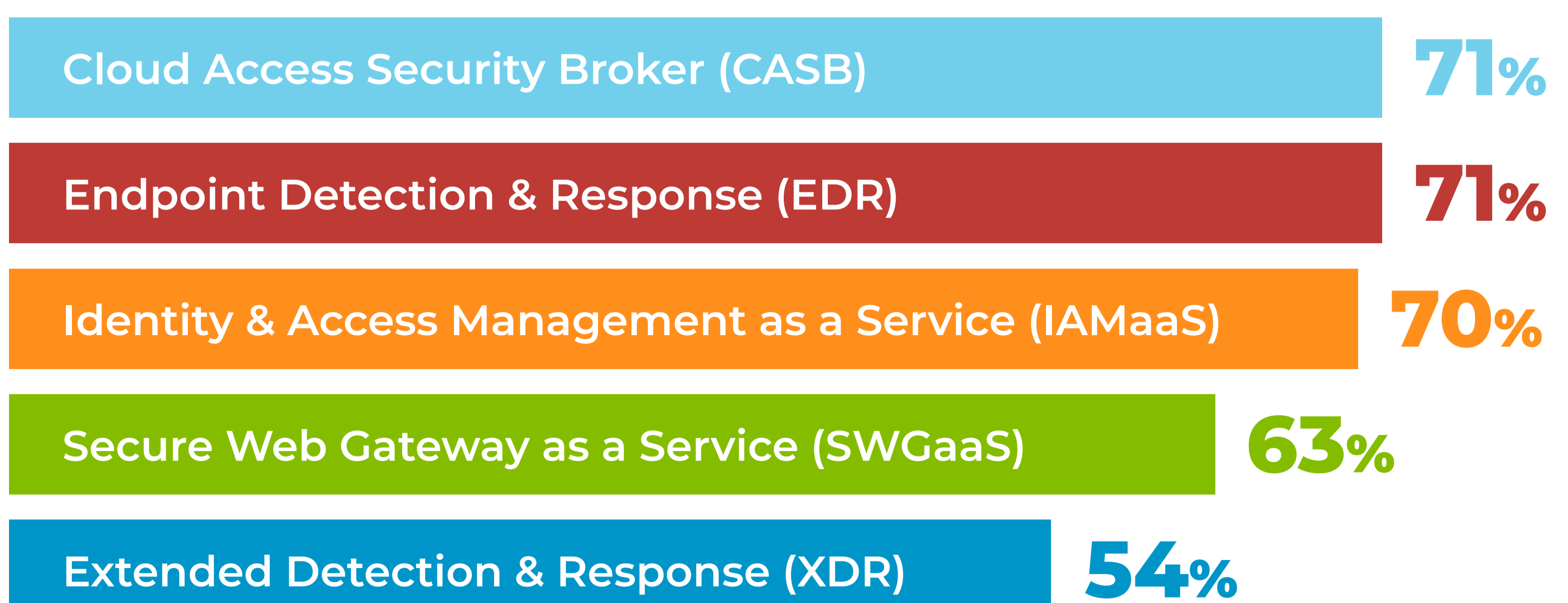
Secure Access Service Edge (SASE) converges SD-WAN and security capabilities into one cloud-based service.
